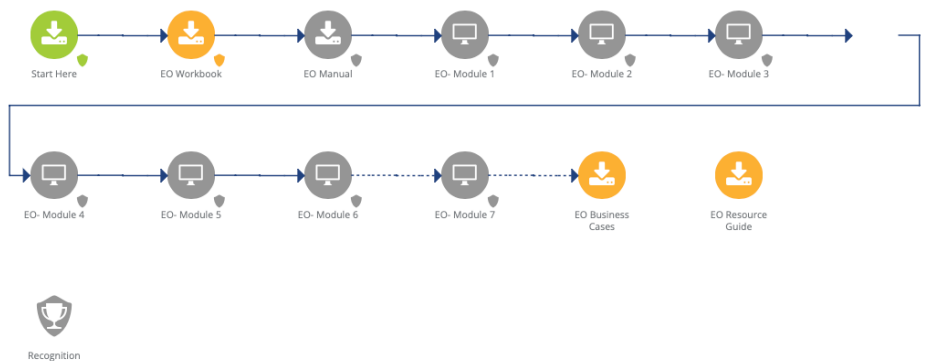
1. Accessing Your Course:

- Bookmark <https://cedtp.skillbuilder.co>
- First time users, create an account.
- Create a username and password to log in.
- Once you are on the platform, go to "Learning Plan" on the left-hand side to see your course(s).

2. Navigating the Learning Path:

- Once you click on your course, the learning path is revealed.
- Click on each item and follow the instructions.
- The Manual and Workbook must be downloaded before you can begin the modules.
- The green indicator means the task is completed; orange indicates an activated item, while grey signals uncompleted learning items.

- Forums, mentioned in the modules and located in the sidebar menu, are intended for learners in groups led by a facilitator. Individual learners should ignore reference to forums in the modules.

3. **The Modules:**

- You'll have the choice to launch each module in either Modal or New Window view.
- Once you have completed a module in Modal View, simply select the "close" button at the bottom of the screen to return to the learning path.
- If you opt for New Window view, navigate back to the top of the menu bar in your browser to return to the learning path.

4. **Course Certificate:**

- Upon completing your course, you'll receive a Course Certificate. Click on the *Trophy Icon* at the end of the course to download it.
